Some items of interest to know:

- 1) **Make up bowling:** If you happen to miss bowling and wish to make it up you have till Wednesday at 6pm to make up bowling. Please call Sunset (568-7999) for open bowling times however typically make up bowling can be done

Saturday from 1-6

Sunday: All Day

Monday: 4-6

Tuesday: 4-6

When you make up bowling tell the person at the front counter you are making up Jr. bowling and give them your scores and money as they should put it in an envelope behind the counter. **PLEASE** be sure to put the Saturday you missed on the sheet!

- 2) **Winter will be here before we know it.** If bowling is cancelled due to inclement weather it will be announced on 97.7 WGLR. Listen to the radio if you have a question about cancellations.
- 3) **Bowling Camp:** Attached is an outline for our general bowling camp on Sunday October 9. There is no need to sign up however I hope to see youth bowlers that have been in our program less than 5 years. The cost will be \$10. This gives us a chance to do some drills, talk to kids more about the game, etc. Any questions please let me know.
- 4) **Bill Spigner Camp:** Bill Spigner is a national bowling coach who will be doing a camp for our Jr/Sr. bowlers on Sunday October 30. Cost is \$100 and it will be from 9am-4pm. Sheet is attached. We need 12 kids in order for this camp to take place. Sign up is necessary for this camp and I need to know before October 16 if you will be attending.

- 5) We are looking for coaches for both shifts. If you would like to help us out please contact Scott.
- 6) We once again this year have the "Gooches Greenhouse Most Pins Over Pizza". Here is how it works. One bowler from the bantam/prep league (9am shift) and one bowler from the junior/senior league (11am shift) that is the most pins over their average for a series will win a 7" pizza from the Greenhouse in Kieler each week! You can only win this once during the year. Thanks to Gooch for his support!
- 7) We have the Sunset Lanes Youth Bowling Cards again this year. This is FREE and gives you discounts on things at Sunset Lanes for just being a member of the youth league (discounts on food and bowling). Thanks to Sunset for sponsoring this once again. If you have not received a card then please talk to Scott!
- 8) We are looking for someone to help with State tournament. This person would be responsible for calling in and getting our times, sending names and line ups to state, etc. If you are interested please let me know!
- 9) We will start to collect money and sign up for state starting soon. If you know your child will be going then the cost of the card is \$15 and Scott has the forms.
- 10) We will have our second annual SMART tournament Sunday November 6 2011. This is a tournament where the youth will bowl 6 games across 12 lanes. Cost is \$40. Prize money that is won will be sent to the USBC in your child's name to be used for college tuition, books, etc. It's a great opportunity for your child to bowl with others and make some money! We have bowlers in our program that has participated in multiple SMART tournaments starting at a young age and has thousands of dollars in their account. For more information ask Scott.
