

Shultzie's Supper Club League (Monday Night) 2011 - 2012 League Rules

1. The league shall consist of 8 teams with a playing strength of 4 women and will be sanctioned by the USBC.
2. The league shall bowl 32 weeks, (includes holidays) with four position rounds. Position rounds are to be in the following order: 9-10, 7-8, 5-6, and 3-4. Regulars need an established average in our league to bowl position matches.
3. Bowling will begin at 6:30 pm each week.
4. Bowling each week is \$11.00 per person and \$44 per team. Breakdown: \$8.25 bowling expense, \$2.25 prize fund, and \$0.50 secretary fees totaling \$11.00.
5. Three games will be bowled each session, with one point awarded for each game won and one point for high team series in the match.
6. The team method of handicapping will be used. The handicap allowance will be 90% and shall be figured on the difference between team averages.
7. For the first nine games bowled regular members and subs will use last year's league average. If no established average, use last year's highest house average. Three games are required to establish an average.
8. The blank score will be highest average for an absent member of the team. Current average less 10 pins. An absent bowler without a current established average will use an average of 120.
9. A list of roving subs shall be maintained by the league. Subs will not be eligible for the league awards. Subs may not bowl on more than one team in the same bowling week scheduled.
10. No new subs the last three weeks.
11. At least two members must be present to complete the first frame of any game or the game will be subject to forfeit. Two regulars and two subs constitute a legal line up. Each captain should decide whether regulars pay for subs.
12. A bowler who arrives late may enter the game; provided three frames have not been completed. The missed frames may be made up. A frame shall be considered complete, when the anchor bowler on each team has thrown her last ball in the frame.
13. Bowling unopposed is permitted. The officers will decide on what is an emergency. A league office does not need to be present, when games are made up and must be bowled before the next league match. A computer print out of the scores must accompany the summary sheet. Bowling must be made up by Saturday. If team forfeits, the other team gets the 4 wins.
14. In the event of a tie for first place, total pins in a one game roll off series shall determine the winner. Any other ties will combine the prize money and split between the tied teams
15. An individual is eligible to win both high series and high game awards (1st - \$10; 2nd - \$6 and 3rd \$4).
16. The league will have a sponsor fee for \$10.00 per team. The first place team will receive \$75.00. It is their responsibility to purchase a trophy for their sponsor, if the sponsor chooses to receive one.
17. The officers together with the team captains shall constitute the board of directors.
18. No children will be allowed below the steps.
19. When you have a sub, she must fill out a sanction card, even if she has been sanctioned in another league. Please see the secretary for a card.
20. Ten members of the league must be present to constitute a quorum in order to conduct business at a meeting.
21. All other USBC bylaws for the current season apply
22. In case of a missed week of bowling for the league, it has been voted to stay with the schedule and not place that week at the end of the season.
23. League will start the new season in the same order as it finished last year. Last year's first place team start on the first lane that will be used.
24. If the league has a ghost team, you need to beat your team average less 10 pins per bowler each game.
25. The over the average pot will be taken up by the team that won first place the previous year.
26. A five-person rooster must be filled out and turned in by the second night of bowling.
27. The fourth place team from the prior year will plan the current year banquet.
